The purpose of this Membership Application Form is to collect data on the individuals identified by this Jurisdictional Member for membership enrollment and/or renewal in IAGR.

Information given to IAGR by Jurisdiction: We collect any information you provide us when you submit the Jurisdictional Membership Application Form. This information includes the individual's name, title/position and email address.
