- Describe how your proposed topic meets the theme of the conference
- What novel or provocative information will you introduce?
- Has the presentation been used previously, if yes, when?

If selected as a speaker, you should be:

- Willing to provide a short video describing your presentation

Accepted speakers need to meet own travel and accommodation costs.




